West Chester Hospital's Imaging Department provides a full gamut of state-of-the-art diagnostic imaging equipment to fulfill the needs of our patients. We strive to meet your needs by providing services at times and locations that are convenient. That's why our diagnostic radiology and CT areas are staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week to provide service to the emergency department, surgical services and inpatient units.

We offer pain management services on a daily basis. These procedures help relieve chronic pain in the back, hip or cervical spine, with or without sedation. These are available to outpatients and inpatients by appointment.

We are staffed every weekday and most weekends for common tests and procedures:
